

The War Writer' Campaign Submission Guidelines

- 1. Once a submission is made, all War Writer executives will thoroughly examine and unanimously approve of the writing before it is adopted to The Campaign. You will be contacted by us if we decide to move forward with your submission.
- 2. War Writers' Campaign executives will work with the author in modifying and editing the submission at that time, with the author having final say in publication once we have completely vetted the work. At any time, the author or The War Writers' Campaign may deny a submission for final publication up to the point of a signed contract.
- 3. Once an agreement between parties has been made, the War Writer must grant exclusive first or reprint rights to The Campaign if the War Writers' Campaign, Inc. chooses to feature the submitted work. These rights will be for a limited period of time based on a mutually agreed-upon contract, and will revert to the author at the end of its terms.
- 4. The Writer must either be a veteran or an immediate family member. Exceptions to this rule will be discussed on a case-by-case basis (please submit any inquiries through the Contact Us page).
- 5. The War Writer must agree to the War Writers' Campaign logo (and any partnership affiliation logo) on their writing for promotional purposes, to show affiliation, and for explanation that 100% of all proceeds go to the War Writers' Campaign, Inc. and our best-in-class partnership programs for veterans.
- 6. The War Writer may never sell their work to anyone outside of a War Writers' Campaign venue once a publishing contract is in place and only for as long as we retain the rights for publication.

THERE IS NO BINDING COMMITMENT OR OBLIGATIONS BY AGREEING TO THESE TERMS OR SUBMITTING WORK TO THE CAMPAIGN.

YOU retain your rights, and The Campaign WILL NOT use your work in ANY way until a mutually agreed-upon contract has been executed or appropriate permissions granted.
